PRAYING THE IGNATIAN WAY

is a way of praying, using Scripture as the medium and a communal setting as the structure aimed at deepening ones relationship with God.

Ignatius of Loyola, born in 1491 at Loyola Castle in Spain, went from being a man of the world to a man of God. While a layman, Ignatius recorded many of his prayer experiences in what is known as The Spiritual Exercises of Ignatius Loyola.

PRAYING THE IGNATIAN WAY

provides opportunities to learn some of the spiritual exercises advocated by Ignatius and opportunities to pray in a group setting.

Ignatian spirituality gives us a structure, a way of proceeding in life, that leads to union with God and a way of finding God in all things.

Jesus is God breaking through into our lives. Through Jesus we come to know and experience God in our lives. When we pray and reflect using Scripture passages, we open ourselves: mind, heart and soul to the possibility of God entering us on a deep profound level.
